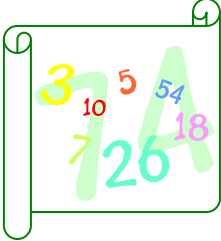
Dear Parents

SUBJECT	CONTENT
English	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◆ To introduce phonic skills through the 'Letters and Sounds' programme.◆ To encourage the development of independent writing and encourage good letter formation.◆ To develop sight vocabulary and introduce reading books.◆ To encourage children to speak confidently.
Mathematics	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◆ To introduce the numbers 0-10 and to develop confidence in practical activities e.g. sorting, matching and number games.◆ To develop knowledge of shape and pattern.
Understanding of the World	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◆ The subject areas covered are Science, History, Geography, PSHE, RE and ICT.◆ The curriculum areas will be delivered through the following topics: Ourselves, Friendships and Christmas.◆ To explore the local environment through 'Welly Walks'.◆ To develop computing skills.
Expressive Art and Design	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◆ To develop drawing skills through observational drawing.◆ To improve fine motor skills through cutting, sticking and other craft.◆ To develop a range of painting skills e.g. printing.◆ To develop the children's enjoyment of music through singing and listening to different kinds of music and rhymes.
Physical Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◆ To introduce team games, incorporating ball skills and the use of small apparatus.◆ To improve co-ordination through dance and movement.

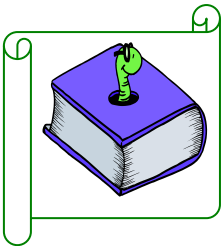
Collective Worship takes place daily for the children to explore our Christian values. When the children are in full time, we will have a class assembly on a Wednesday and Friday.

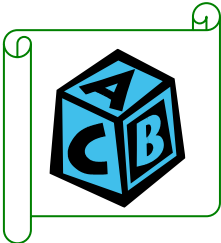
NUMERACY

Counting practice and number formation practice at home.



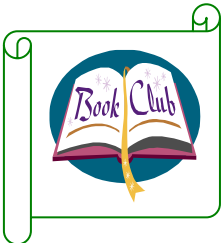
LITERACY
