Dear Parents

This letter is designed to provide key information about learning this term.

SUBJECT	CONTENT
English	To develop skills of speaking and listening for a wide range of purposes in different contexts. To read and write for a range of purposes by developing word recognition, decoding (reading) and encoding (spelling). Children will be able to understand and interpret different texts and engage and respond to them. They will create texts which work on sentence structure, punctuation, grammar and presentation.
Mathematics	Following the Year 2 Mathematical National Curriculum objectives, children will focus on; ♦ Number and place value (steps of 2, 5 and 0 in 10s) ♦ Addition and subtraction inc. facts to 20 ♦ Measures inc: money and problems, lengths and sequencing intervals of time. ♦ Multiplication and division (2s, 5s and 10s), odd and even numbers, arrays and repeated addition.
Science	<u>Materials</u> : Children will identify the suitability of different materials and decide if they are fit for purpose through sorting and comparisons.
Computing	TIOL: Children will learn about everyday technology in their lives. E-safety: Children will agree class internet and safety rules. Creating Media: Children will learn how to use technology to take and edit photographs.
Geography	Passport to the world: Children will be able to recognise where they live and locate it on a map. They will use simple maps to locate continents and understand what links the other UK has to the world.
History	Remembrance: Children will look at significant events from the past and how these influence the world they live in today; they will pay particular attention to their local area.
RE	Judaism and The Torah: Children will learn why The Torah is important to Jewish people. Incarnation: Children will explore why Christmas matters to Christians.
Music	Ourselves, toys and animals: Children will learn to keep a steady beat and change tempo whilst creating rhymical patterns. Nativity performance: Year 2 will perform a Nativity to parents.
Art	<u>Craft and Design—Map it Out</u> : Children will develop patterns using shapes and a range of materials.
DT	Mechanisms: Children will create a working fairground wheel using different materials. Cooking and Nutrition: Understanding a balanced diet.
PE	Gymnastics: Children will focus on balance, rotations and how to travel safely whilst using apparatus.
PSHCE/RSE	Me and my relationships: Children will focus on bullying and teasing through clear school rules. They will also look at their how to be a good friend and their feelings. Valuing differences: Children will celebrate differences and how to be kind to others.

MATHS

Activities to support and enhance classroom learning.

ENGLISH

Activities to support and enhance classroom learning, including reading.

Written tasks should be completed using a sharp

pencil rather than a pen. This is a good opportunity for children to reinforce good handwriting and accurate spelling. The activities may have a cross curricular link.



SPELLING

Your child will bring home a list of spellings on Wednesdays. There will be a spelling test on Tuesdays

They will need to complete an activity on the spelling sheet. At the beginning of Autumn term, we focus upon the spelling of commonly used words that the children should spell accurately.



READING

10-15 minutes reading every day.

We would appreciate a few comments in the reading record book once you have heard your child read. This is useful even if you choose to read a book that is not the scheme book that we have sent home.

- Homework is given out on Wednesdays. It is due back in school on the following Tuesday.
