(Choose one):

Write a story or diary entry from the perspective of the school building itself. What stories has it witnessed over 150 years?

• School in the Year 2175

Imagine what our school might be like 150 years from now. What will classrooms look like? How will pupils learn? Create an exciting story or description of the school's future!

Entry Categories

- Lower KS2 (Years 3-4)
- Upper KS2 (Years 5-6)

Word Count

- Years 3–4: Up to 300 words
- Years 5–6: Up to 500 words

Prizes

- **Winners** from each category will receive a book voucher.
- Winning stories will be published in a commemorative school anthology and read aloud at the anniversary celebration.

Judging Criteria

- 1. Creativity and imagination
- 2. Clear structure and engaging writing
- 3. Connection to the school and the 150-year theme
- 4. Age-appropriate spelling, grammar, and punctuation
